

History Majors Checklist

The following checklist is intended to assist students in determining which courses they need in order to meet the requirements for a degree in History. It is an informal document that is intended to supplement the Registrar's Audit.

PREAMBLE: DECLARING A MAJOR

Students may declare a history major at any time during their undergraduate career, although university regulations require that students declare a major (in something!) by the beginning of their third year. To declare a major in history does not require the approval of the History Department, although we would be happy to consult and advise. All a student need do to declare their major is to fill out the required form at the Registrar's Office.

A. GENERAL DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Please consult the calendar to ensure that you meet the **general UPEI requirements** for an Arts degree. These are the principal ones:

- 120 semester hours of credit _____
- Of the 42 semester hours required for a major, **at least 30** semester hours must be completed with grades of 60% or better _____
- At least one-half of the courses for a degree must be completed at UPEI _____
- In the last 60 semester hours of course work, **no more than 12** can be completed at a university other than UPEI _____
- All students working toward an undergraduate degree or diploma will be required to take one of the following three courses, recommended to be taken within the first three semesters of registration, to fulfill graduation requirements:
 - UPEI 1010 - Writing Studies: Engaging Writing, Rhetoric, and Communication;
 - UPEI 1020 - Inquiry Studies: Engaging Ideas and Cultural Contexts; or
 - UPEI 1030 - University Studies: Engaging University Contexts and Experience;
 - AND One Writing Intensive Course _____
- **No more than 48** semester hours of credit can be taken at the introductory level _____
- Students expecting to graduate in the current academic year must make formal application to graduate (which can be done on-line using your campus log-in) by 31 October of the academic year in which they expect to complete the requirements. _____
